





Lumière Wins Interior Design Best of Year 2012

30 November 2012 – Lumière, Phoenix Property Investors' Luxury Condominium Project in Taipei, won the prestigious Best of Year Award at last night's 7th Annual Interior Design Best of Year Awards.

Over 800 people from the design community gathered at the state of the art auditorium and event space at 200 West Street in New York City, to celebrate the best projects and products of 2012. Best of Year Project Design honorees were selected by Editor-in-Chief, Cindy Allen and a jury of design leaders from over 550 project submissions. Lumière won in the category of Model Apartment/Public Space.

Designed by world-renowned architect Calvin Tsao from TsAO & McKown, these spacious apartments have been designed to maximize every view and every angle to create the optimum living space. Set on a hill in the neighborhood of Tien Mu in Taipei, Lumière gives you the feel of an urban retreat with breathtaking views of the city, but the quiet solitude and lushness of a private eden.

Inspired by the power of place and human experience, Lumière's style and design is not only a reflection of the spirit and culture of its location, but a celebration of it. Local materials were used in its construction and local artists were commissioned to create decorative pieces for the public spaces. Throughout the design process, Tsao carefully selected materials to create a visual and sensorial experience that would resonate with local residents and give them a sense of wellness and comfort.

Unique to its time and place, Lumière manages to feel both intimate and luxurious with 8 spacious 3-bedroom apartments, a full-floor penthouse unit, a Private Resident's Club and rooftop lounge.
